| <p>Autumn term 2018 The Nursery manager and her staff will use the 'I can' 'Early talk boost' programme, for 0 – 5 year olds. 2 groups of children are to be supported during the Autumn term, For 4 of these children, we receive EYPP Nursery funding. The Nursery manager will meet all individual parents to share details of this language programme.</p> | <p><u>Aims:</u> This programme narrows the gap between 3 – 4 year olds with language delay and their peers. No child should be left out or behind because of a difficulty in speaking or understanding. Practitioner training carried out last year, is being used as part of how we support vital areas of development for all of our children.</p> | <p>N/A</p> | <p>2 groups of children are to receive group support during the Autumn term 2018.</p> | <p>The programme has a recommended baseline which will be used at the start of the programme, with an assessment on completion, to demonstrate impact.</p> |
| <p>Spring term 2019 Training for all Nursery staff on 4th January 2019. 'Read, Write, Inc' phonics training.</p> | <p>In school training</p> | <p><u>Total</u> £500 £129.14 has been funded as carried over from the last academic year, with a top up of £370.86 from the 2018/19 EYPP Nursery funding.</p> | <p>4th January 2019</p> | <p>Impact January 2019: An additional staff led daily story time session has been introduced in addition to carpet story sessions. Spring term impact: The children are developing a further understanding of story structure, rhythm and rhyme. This is furthering the children's phonological awareness.</p> |
