<p>Autumn term 2019 Nursery staff will use the 'I can' Early talk boost programme for 0 – 5 year olds, with designated pupils, including 2 funded by the EYPP grant.</p> <p>October 2019: 17 x 'Jake and Tizzy' books purchased to enable this intervention to continue.</p>	<p><u>Intervention:</u> This programme narrows the gap between 3 – 4 year olds with language delay and their peers. No child should be left out or behind because of a difficulty in speaking or understanding.</p> <p><u>Expected outcomes:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will listen to others either 1:1 or within a small group. • Listen to stories with increasing attention and recall. • Begin to understand prepositions by carrying out an action or by selecting an appropriate picture. • Begin to use more complex sentences to link thoughts. 	<p>£111.83</p>	<p>Autumn term 2019</p> <p>Spring term 2020</p>	<p>The programme has a recommended baseline which will be used at the start of the programme, with an assessment on completion, to demonstrate impact.</p> <p><u>Autumn term 2019 progress:</u> A child in receipt of EYPP grant funding, has been supported using this programme and it has shown good impact re their speaking; listening and understanding. The child has made accelerated progress in these areas of learning.</p> <p><u>Next steps:</u> The 'I can early talk boost programme' is to continue during the Spring term 2020. Stopped due to Covid 19 mid- March 2020. New staff member to be trained in the next academic year as trained staff members have now left our Nursery.</p>

<p>Autumn term 2019</p> <p>Mixed apparatus purchased to encourage creativity, curiosity and motivation.</p> <p>Materials provided which can be combined; re designed and used in multiple ways.</p>	<p>Loose parts purchased along with storage, including: Building blocks; wooden numbers; cork tops varying in size; bamboo circles & peg dolls.</p> <p><u>Expected outcomes:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Natural objects provided to spark curiosity. • Encourage counting and the recognition of numerals representing 0 – 5 then 1 – 10. • Children beginning to categorise objects according to properties such as shape or size. 	<p>£176.69</p>	<p>Academic year 2019 - 2020</p>	<p><u>Impact to the end of January 2020:</u> All EYPP Nursery funded children have had access to this equipment and it has had an impact on: Creativity; Imaginative thinking; levels of engagement; problem solving; decision making; experimenting & testing. The equipment has also helped in maintaining focus.</p> <p>Ongoing for general use in the Nursery.</p> <p><u>Summer impact:</u> The equipment has been made available to all pupils throughout the academic year, cementing the skills outlined above.</p>
<p>Autumn term 2019</p> <p>Sensory items purchased for pupil(s) with additional sensory needs, including a child in receipt of EYPP Nursery funding.</p>	<p>Large colour changing LED water bubble lamp with fish.</p> <p>Infinity mirror tunnel lamp with LED lighting.</p> <p><u>Expected outcomes:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To provide a calm and nurturing environment for children with extra sensory needs. • Developing a growing ability to soothe themselves. 	<p>£26.50</p> <p>£11.49</p>	<p>Autumn term 2019</p>	<p><u>Autumn term 2019 impact:</u> An EYPP Nursery child has had regular access to this equipment and the items purchased have allowed the child to help regulate emotions in order to better access learning & play. (All Nursery children have had access to the sensory items.)</p> <p>Ongoing into the Spring and Summer terms 2020. The child is using these sensory items regularly and it has helped to ease his transition back into the Nursery setting after lockdown due to Covid19.</p>

<p>32 x books to use at teacher led carpet times.</p> <p>EYPP Nursery funded children remaining at this setting into September 2020, will be provided with Summer holiday 'goody' bags.</p>	<p>As a starter of learning activities.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To give children a good model of language and to extend vocabulary. • Children are able to follow a story without pictures or props and to listen with increasing attention and recall. • Becoming aware of the way in which stories are structured. <p>A Summer holiday bag will be provided containing an advice sheet for sharing nursery rhymes; a hand puppet to develop language and story - telling skills; number beads and threads to support fine motor and number skills and a story book to share with an adult/older sibling.</p>	<p>£234.88</p> <p>No additional costs expected as bags were collated last Summer and we do not anticipate needing additional stock.</p>	<p>Academic year 2019 - 2020</p> <p>July 2020</p>	<p><u>Impact to the end of January 2020:</u> All Nursery children have used the new books during adult led carpet time. They have added value to carpet time, extending the children's vocabulary to which they are exposed & have modified good book handling.</p> <p><u>Next steps:</u> To explore the remaining books at carpet time.</p> <p><u>Spring and Summer terms 2020:</u> We have continued to explore more new books when in school – this will carry over into our learning in September.</p> <p><u>July 2020:</u> One bag has been provided for a Nursery EYPP funded child to use in learning through play situations with their family over the Summer holidays. To be kept by the family. Main goals: To have mixed learning materials at home for use during the Summer holidays; to further develop language acquisition & to share and discuss story books; to develop Number skills through games and increase fine motor control skills using mixed resources.</p>
